## SECC-Best of SCCM Congress 2021 Taipei Report

Hybrid physical and online conference

SECC-Best of SCCM Congress 2021 Taipei took place on 18-19 December 2021 in Taipei as a hybrid physical and online conference during a COVID-19 pandemic era.

2559 online and onsite participants from 45 countries attended the two-day conference, including 1840 domestic participants and 719 oversea participants. The extensive scientific programme developed between SCCM, TSCCM (Taiwan Society of Critical Care Medicine), TSECCM (Taiwan Society of Emergency and Critical Care Medicine), and Asian Society partners. The congress theme this year is "Discover Smart Emergency & Critical Care in the Era of COVID-19" comprised Smart Emergency & Critical Care (SECC) and the top sessions and most relevant topics for the region selected from SCCM 50<sup>th</sup> Critical Care Congress (Best of SCCM). The SECC course covered topics as diverse as database and data science, sepsis management, COVID-19, extracorporeal life support, renal critical care, AKI, neuro critical care, nutrition, quality management and patient safety. The Best of SCCM course included comprehensive content of the plenaries, year-in-review sessions, and selected adult and pediatric lectures from SCCM's Congress.



59 abstracts were accepted, including all stimulating ideas and data from perspectives around the world. 48 e-poster and 18 oral presentations related to SECC were selected and presented hybrid online and on-site. With the support and sponsorship of our industry partners, the conference featured demonstrations of many of the latest products and advanced services available to intensive care professionals.

## EuroAsia 2020 Report

Hybrid physical and online conference

Fourth annual EuroAsia conference

EuroAsia 2020 took place on 12-13 September 2020 in Taipei as a hybrid physical and online conference during a COVID-19 pandemic era.

Almost 3,300 online participants from 88 countries and 1,300 on-site participants attended the two-day conference. The extensive scientific programme – developed between ESICM, TSCCM (Taiwan Society of Critical Care Medicine), TSECCM (Taiwan Society of Emergency and Critical Care Medicine), and Asian Society partners - comprised a broad range of key lectures and interactive courses, covering topics as diverse as database and data science, sepsis management, COVID-19, extracorporeal life support, hemodynamic monitoring, quality management, immune dysfunction, nutrition, and patient safety.



90 abstracts were presented, all stimulating ideas and data from both European and Asian perspectives. 31 were hybrid online and on-site oral presentations, 59 were video presentations broadcast from the official website of EuroAsia 2020.
